Policy on Creating and Awarding Presidential Awards

Policy Statement

In the course of University events, there are times when the President would like to bestow recognition, other than an honorary degree or alumni awards, on members of the internal and external community for recognition of outstanding service or exemplary achievement. The purpose of this Policy is to recognize the President's ability to bestow such awards.

The University reserves the right to modify or amend this Policy at any time, at its sole discretion. Any change to this Policy will become effective at the time designated above, and the changes will apply to both prospective students and those already enrolled. This Policy does not constitute an express or implied contract between Rooseveltiversity and any past, present, or prospective student, employee (including administrator, faculty, or staff), contractor, or volunteer. Unless otherwise stated, the term "Employee" as used in this Policy shall refer to all employees (including administrator, faculty, and staff), contractors, and volunteers.

Policy

The President shall have the discretion to award individuals and organizations at any time. There is no limit to the number of awards or the frequency with which the President may bestow such an award. Nothing in this Policy shall be construed to require the President to bestow any such awards. The following are the Presidential Awards:

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the highest honor gien by Roosevelt University Pres who exhibit outstanding commitment to the spirit achievement in the areas of social justice and civic

Presidential Citation for Service to Roosevelt Universident or organizations by the President for execuses of Roosevelt University.
